Zachary Boxx granted parole

An offender convicted of the manslaughter of a man during a home invasion in Orange in March 2006 in the company of three co-offenders has been granted parole by the State Parole Authority (SPA).

The Authority granted Zachary Boxx parole at a meeting on 25 June 2015 with strict conditions including being banned from contacting the victim's family.

Boxx, now 28, was aged nineteen at the time of the offence and has served almost 7 years 6 months of a maximum 10 year sentence. He will be subject to strict parole supervision until February 2018 including:

- ongoing psychological intervention
- banned from contacting or associating with his co-offenders
- banned from contact with the victim's family.

His parole was recommended by the Community Corrections Division of Corrective Services NSW. The Service advised the Parole Authority that the offender had completed relevant programs and counselling in custody and remained gainfully employed for most of his sentence including participating in external work programs.

The Parole Authority was also advised that the offender had strong family support and suitable post release plans.

Boxx is due to be released on 28 August 2015.
