### **PAROLE REVOKED FOR MILTON ORKOPOULOS**

The State Parole Authority today revoked the parole order for Milton Orkopoulos.

The decision was made at a closed meeting this afternoon during which the SPA panel considered a breach report outlining outstanding charges against the offender.

The Authority revoked the order on the basis the offender had breached two conditions of his parole, namely that he “must not commit any offences” and “must comply with all conditions and requirements of the Child Protection Register (CPR).”

Orkopoulos was refused bail after appearing in court last week (February 20), charged with three counts of failing to comply with reporting conditions of the CPR.

He remains in custody.
