Gang rapist to remain in gaol

A man convicted of the gang rape of Sydney women in 2000 was today refused parole by the NSW State Parole Authority.

Mohamed Sanoussi, aged 27, has already served 11 years of a maximum 16 year sentence. He was first eligible for parole in 2010.

The State Parole Authority refused his release for the second consecutive year, recommending he address his offending behaviour and undergo further drug and alcohol counselling.

The Serious Offenders Review Council (SORC) supports today's decision.

In a report tendered to the hearing, SORC recommended the inmate take part in further education programs.

Sanoussi was sentenced to a maximum 16 years gaol for his involvement in two gang rapes in Sydney, in August 2000.
