## OFFENDER LJUBE VELEVSKI REFUSES PAROLE

The State Parole Authority (SPA) today declined to consider parole for offender Ljube Veleviski after he refused to make an application.

In 1997, the offender was sentenced to a maximum sentence of 25 years for the murders of his wife and three children at the family home, in Berkeley, in Wollongong's south.

He was sentenced to a non-parole period of 19 years, which expired in 2016.

The offender has declined to seek parole since becoming eligible.

His sentence expires in 2022.
