MILTON ORKOPOULOS DECLINES TO SEEK PAROLE

Offender Milton Orkopoulos has advised the State Parole Authority he is not seeking parole and will serve the balance of his parole in custody.

The SPA formally declined parole today, accepting also the advice of the Serious Offenders Review Council that release was not appropriate.

Orkopoulos will remain in custody until 18 October 2021 when his maximum sentence of 13 years and 8 months expires.

Background:

- Milton Orkopoulos was released to supervised parole on 20 December 2019
- The SPA revoked parole after NSW Police charged him with failing to comply with reporting conditions of the Child Protection Register
- He was returned to custody on 26 February 2020
- While in custody for breaching his parole, Orkopoulos was further charged by NSW Police with historical child sex and drug supply offences, allegedly committed between 1994 – 2001
