REVOCACTION ORDER CONFIRMED FOR MILTON ORKOPOULOS

The State Parole Authority today confirmed the revocation of parole order for offender Milton Orkopoulos will stand.

The decision followed a review hearing today, during which the SPA heard Orkopoulos was convicted and sentenced last December for failing to comply with reporting conditions of the Child Protection Register.

The Authority also noted the offender faces additional outstanding charges.

The matter was stood over for a parole consideration meeting on April 16, with the SPA requesting updated reports, including one from the Serious Offenders Review Council.

Orkopoulos had his revoked parole in February 2020 and he has remained in custody since that time.

While in custody, he was charged by NSW Police with child sex and drug supply offences, allegedly committed between 1994 - 2001.

The sentence, for which his parole was revoked, expires 18 October 2021.
